Pledge of Allegiance

- Tom waived reading of last month minutes – approved
- Joe – Kitchen going good
- Joe – research on Security Companies
There is no WI-FI connection to monitor cameras. There is a lack of lighting to put cameras everywhere. To put in four infrared cameras and four recorders for the range would be \$2000.00 for equipment only.
- Tom – checking on cost of getting WI-FI for club
- All agreed we will not invest that much money into infrared cameras. Will look into getting a couple of cameras around the pavilion to start.
- Tom – move to change rules to say “Any use of broad heads except in the broad head pit will result in termination of club membership” Bill passed
- Mike – auctioning off all McKenzie targets at the next 3-D shoot which will be at the club championship on March 13-15th
- Bill – a new calendar of events was created and posted but still need to be delivered to Bass Pro Shop.
- The club championship will be for 3 days March 13-15th and will include 1 red range for a 20 target 3-D. 1 blue range for a 20 target 3-D range and the field range will be on the walk-back range with hunter field targets and yardage.
- Joe and Ben will handle the food for the club championship.
- Lee to check with Lee County on the club boundaries and Ron will create maps and install in Plexiglas frames around the range. This will insure safety and inforce a one way path around the range.

- Rick – to be in charge of safety committee and do an internal safety audit.
